Programme Highlights

The visit will include a presentation on nuclear power, the Exhibition Centre, and viewing of the Daya Bay Nuclear Power Station, Ling Ao Nuclear Power Station and the construction site of Ling Ao Nuclear Power Station Phase 2. The aim is to promote the understanding of members on the issues related to nuclear power generation and the status of nuclear power in Guangdong.
