He/she will liaise with Government, guide University leaders and help steer University committees towards engaging and sustaining HSE programs that meet international best practice. The appointee will oversee the University's Health, Safety and Environment Office, the Sustainability Unit, the Center for Laboratory Supplies, the provision of student medical services through the on-campus medical clinic, the student dental clinic and the occupational medicine service.

**The Candidate**

*Applicants should have a doctoral degree in Science or Engineering plus appropriate professional qualifications. They should have a pertinent vision and rich experience in leadership roles in risk management of various physical, chemical, biological and ergonomic hazards encountered in teaching and research in higher education. Proven ability to network with local and international stakeholders in university HSE management is highly desirable.*

Appointment to the position will be on a three-year contract, renewable subject to mutual agreement. Competitive remuneration and generous fringe benefits including annual leave, medical, dental and housing benefits where applicable will be provided. A gratuity will be payable upon successful completion of contract.
