The examination fee is valid for one attempt within TWO years from the date of the first launch of the application. Candidates will have to pay the examination fee again on each re-entry (written exam = \$1,600; oral exam = \$1,500) subsequent to an unsuccessful attempt.

For candidates who have failed their RPH examinations, RPH R&EB will only keep their application forms for 25 months from the date of form submission if there is no outstanding process. Afterwards, the forms will be destroyed for protection of personal data. If the candidate applies to sit the RPH examination again within this 25-month period, his/her application fee (HK\$ 600) will be exempted and he/she only has to pay the examination fee. But this exemption is just for once in this period. If the candidate applies to sit the RPH examination again after the 25-month period, he/she has to submit an application form and pay the application fee afresh.

Application fee and written exam fee are normally non-refundable. Oral exam fee is non-refundable except that a candidate has failed his/her written exam and then requests for a refund of the oral exam fee. Such refund request shall be made within 25 months from the date of his/her application form submission; otherwise any request for refund will not be processed. The candidate has to pay the application fee afresh if he/she applies for the RPH examination again.

Agreement and professional ethics

Persons who have been accepted by the Registered Professional Hygienist Registration & Examination Board (RPH R&EB) and granted the title of Registered Professional Hygienist (RPH) have the right to use the title – RPH for a 5-year period, and they must maintain the professional development competence within the 5-year cycle. In addition, they MUST observe the follows rules:-

- (a) Every RPH shall at all times so order his or her conduct as to uphold the dignity and reputation of the profession of occupational and environmental hygiene and to safeguard the public interest in matters of health and safety and otherwise. He or she shall exercise his or her profession skill and judgment to the best of his or her ability and discharge his or her responsibility with integrity.
- (b) Each RPH shall observe the Code of Ethics agreed upon and promulgated by the RPH R&EB of HKIOEH. The Code is usually publicised in the website of HKIOEH and will be reviewed periodically to match with the IOHA code of ethics as far as possible.
- (c) Each RPH shall not use his/her RPH title or registration as credentials in unrelated discipline (e.g. food hygiene) or for performance of duties in unrelated disciplines.
- (d) Each RPH shall have right to express his or her opinion on the institute and in the science and practice of occupational and environmental hygiene. The opinion may be in the form of written communication to the RPH R&EB. Unless the communication is considered by the RPH R&EB of HKIOEH as personal attack or irrelevant to the opinion of the institute, the written communication shall be distributed to other RPHs on the list within reasonable time. The person shall reduce the written communication to less than one thousand words if requested by the RPH R&EB of HKIOEH.

The title of RPH will be removed from the list of RPH accordingly when it has been proved and agreed by the RPH R&EB of HKIOEH that the person fails to the said rules.
