



Reflection on Occupational Health Service after the SARS Epidemic

The SARS outbreak in 2003 has infected more than 380 health care workers including doctors, nurses and supporting staff of whom the majority had worked within the public health care system. The two pressing questions are: “Have we got a system in place to protect the health and safety of the employees at the health care facilities?” and “How can we do better to protect them should SARS or other infectious disease strike again?”
